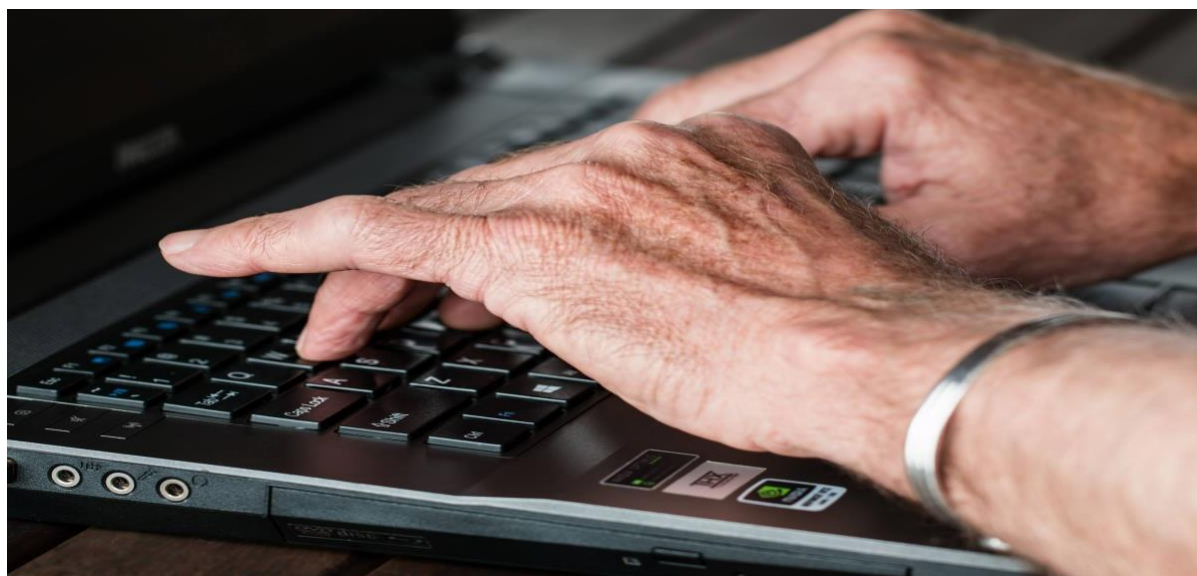


**MEDLIT#45+ PROJECT  
PRESS RELEASE**

The MedLit-45 Project with the completion of the Output 3 have reached the final stage. During the last period, in each of the six partner countries (Romania, Greece, United Kingdom, Italy, Portugal and Spain) the partners have carried out the full activities and created innovative digital outputs. The Output 3 is the Manual for professionals supporting unemployed persons. The aim of O3 is to promote the use of the skills building framework and the platform to professionals and organizations active in providing training and support services to low-skilled/low-qualified unemployed persons over 45. The Manual is a comprehensive resource containing the results of the first 2 outputs of the project. Specifically, are made available all the process and activities carried out in order to developing the digital/media competences of low-skilled unemployed adults 45+ through innovative tools. Moreover, the contents proposed aim to enhance the knowledge of employment/career counsellors and/or relevant authorities, equipping them with a new approach & tools for supporting and interacting with middle-aged unemployed persons through social media. The manual also describes the procedure carried out by each partner for creating the contents of the E-learning platform. The Platform has been tasted in every partner country. Around 120 users were involved in the pilot phase offering important insights on the impact created by the digital tool. In the coming months the partnership will present the Outputs created through multiplier events thus spreading the knowledge about the project at local level, trying to raise the awareness of stakeholders and general public.
